To change the columns on your Inogen One® G5, first:

- Turn off the Inogen One® G5 concentrator by pressing the power button to shut down the device.
- Remove the Inogen One® G5 concentrator from the carrying case (if attached).



Remove the battery from the Inogen One® G5 concentrator.



Place the Inogen One® G5 concentrator on its side so that the underside is visible. The metal column assembly can be seen on one side of the device.



Unlock the column assembly by pushing the latch button away from the columns.



While holding the button open, slide the column assembly out of the device by pulling on the column pull handle.




Remove the columns completely from the Inogen One® G₅. Both columns are removed as one piece.





Remove dust caps of new coulmn assembly. Make sure there is no dust or debris where the dust caps were located.





